We use behavioral, electrophysiological, molecular, imaging, and anatomical methods. If you have a preference regarding these specializations, please specify this in your application and also explain why in general you want to work with us. Please take care that your English is spotless.

We do not have a fixed amount of internship positions. An internship is possible as soon as a researcher is in need of an intern and has the possibility to supervise him/her during the time you specified.
